

## **What Do People Like About This Method?**

The people to whom I have taught this method have found that it's simple and useful. They liked it because:

- They were able to cast and interpret a hexagram at any time and place for themselves.
- The scores were not value judgements, but simply indications of how a certain course-of-action was aligned with the developing situation.
- The scores made it easier to compare different courses-of-action. For example, if one course-of-action had a rating of +73% and another had a rating of -23%, then it was easy to see which option was better aligned and by how much. Alternatively, if the two options had ratings of +58% and +61%, then there was little difference between them.

- They developed a greater sense of moving with the flow of the situation rather than pushing and straining against the current of events.
- **Above all, this method helped them to think about their plans and their situation more thoroughly and it often stimulated them to find new possibilities they hadn't considered at first.**
